

The Board of Pharmacy has received notice of the following product recall. The Board strongly encourages pharmacies to immediately review their quality assurance and recall policies and procedures to determine if any corrective action is required.

Wedgewood Pharmacy is conducting a recall of a sterile compounded veterinary medication Neomycin (as Sulfate)/Polymyxin B (as Sulfate)/ Prednisolone Acet. 3.5mg/l 0000u/1%/gm in Artificial Tears ophthalmic ointment (3.5 gm). The preparations were compounded exclusively for use in animals.

The pharmacy is recalling the following lots: 000-02214825, 000-02210219, 000-02205573, 000-2196777, and 000-02188529, of which two hundred eighty-one (281) units were dispensed to a total of thirty-two (32) California customers. Wedgewood initiated the recall after a quality review indicated that the potency of Neomycin (as Sulfate) in some units of the aforementioned lots may be lower than the intended amount of 3.5 mg/gm.
