

The Board of Pharmacy has received notice of the following product recall. The Board strongly encourages pharmacies to immediately review their quality assurance and recall policies and procedures to determine if any corrective action is required.

Amivas is recalling:

- **ARTESUNATE FOR INJECTION**
- **AMIVAS LOT NUMBERS AR480E01, AR480E02, AR480E03**
- **CARDINAL HEALTH PACKAGING SOLUTIONS LOT NUMBER 7507001, 7508001**
- **ITEM/NDC: 7360700110T / 7360700110 and 7360700111T / 7360700111**
- **UPC 373607-001115, 373607-001108**

This recall has been initiated due to a post integrity testing (bubble point) failure of an air filter (filter cartridge MCY 4463, Junior Emflon, Pall Product ID MCY4463PFRPH4) connected to a semi-automatic crimper (FlexSeal 10 Semi-Automatic Crimper, DCL #001578) used for crimp sealing of Artesunate for Injection drug product batches in Room 227 (class A environment).

Amivas began shipping this product on March 31, 2021. The released quantity of the 2-pack was 256 boxes (Item number 7360700111) and the 4-pack was 122 boxes (7360700110). The following quantities are in the supply chain as of September 27, 2021:

- 12 x 2 packs at Cardinal Health 3PL; and
- Unknown quantity that may be unused at hospitals.
